


Topic To investigate ways to filter water	<p>Water filtration.</p> <p>Look at water collected from the the Kingdom of Junglewast on Alchemy island. (Water and mud should make a nice mixture, although you could use your imagination for this bit!) How could you describe this water? Use dirty water ALB to help with this. Try to use scientific names if possible.
