**Welcome Back:** We hope you all had a lovely Easter and we are very excited to begin our Summer Term.

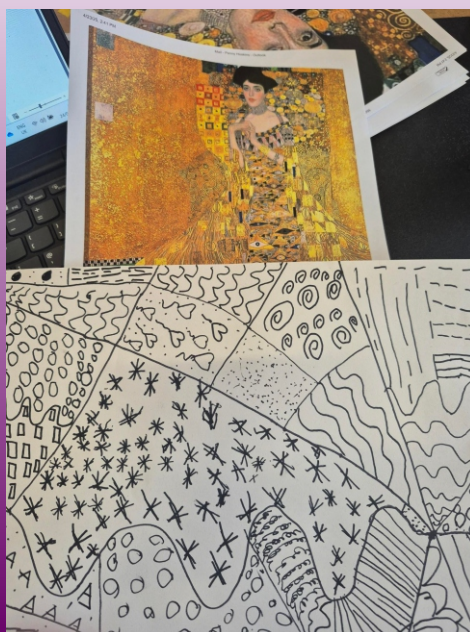
**INSET Day:** A reminder that the school will be closed for INSET on **Tuesday 6th May**.
