This project teaches children about water, including floating and sinking, freezing and melting, and why it is important for living things to stay hydrated.

Activities you could try at home

- Explore different objects and see whether they float or sink when put in water – This could be something to explore in the bath!
- Find some containers to fill and empty using water. Can you fill a container using different sized spoons?
- Have a go at making an ice lolly. What flavours will you use? Will you add fruit to it?
- Explore ice. Where can you put the ice to make it melt? Freeze toy animals or leaves on ice, can you get them out?
- Can you find animals that live in water? What one is your favourite? Where do they live? Have a go at making a collage of your animal.
