Car Park Arrangements: From Monday 8th March we will be implementing the changes to the car park arrangements originally planned for January. This still includes the staggered starts and finishes, plus the following changes originally announced in December to try and make these run more smoothly and safely.

- Please can parents / carers not arrive on site until after 9.10 a.m. and 3.10 p.m. Prior to these times please do NOT wait by the garages on the school drive, please stay offsite altogether.
- If you are walking, please can you walk straight down using the pedestrian marked path and then along the front of the building to your class pick up point.
- Parents driving into school will be directed to park up using both lanes all around the car park. Please wait by your car and once all the cars are in, staff will bring the pupils out to you. Once all the pupils are in their cars, the barrier will be removed and all the cars will leave at the same time, ensuring there is no movement in the car park before all the pupils are safely loaded.
- Your child's teacher is always happy to speak to you, but please can you contact them via e-schools and they will arrange a convenient time, rather than speaking to them at drop off or collection times as this will make the car park safer for everyone.
