School Christmas Dinner: Next Tuesday 16th December we are having our school Christmas dinner. Unless your child is in receipt of income related Free School Meals or is entitled to Universal Infant Free School Meals for all students in Reception, Yr1 and Yr2, the cost is £2.95 (for students up to Year 9) or £3.20 (for students in Years 10-14.)
